Dear Families, Residents, and Staff,

The CDC and the Department of Public Health have given us updated guidance on visitation. Below is how we are proceeding with their guidance:

- Visitors will continue to be screened in the lobby by having their temperature taken and being asked a series of questions regarding their health and if they have had any exposure to COVID-19.
- <u>All visitors will be required to wear a mask for the duration of their visit and practice</u> good hand hygiene throughout their visit.
- Visitors who <u>are not fully</u>vaccinated, will need to continue to schedule theirin house or outdoor visits with Kristy Egan by calling 508-755-8605ext. 126 or kegan@saintfrancisrehab.com. We will ask that visitors that are not fully vaccinated continue to receive a Binax NOW COVID test prior to the start of their visit. Visitors will be required to practice social distancing (minimum of 6 feet apart) as well as wear a mask and practice good hand hygiene throughout their visit.
- All visitors who are <u>FULLY</u> vaccinated may visit their loved ones in their bedrooms without maintaining social distancing, <u>IF</u> their loved one is also fully vaccinated,<u>and</u> their loved one's roommate is fully vaccinated.<u>Please note</u> – if your loved is fully vaccinated <u>but</u>their roommate is not you may not visit in your loved one's bedroom.
- Please note, the definition of being FULLY vaccinated is <u>received both required doses</u> of the Moderna or the Pfizer vaccine and it has been at least two weeks since the 2nd dose of their vaccine or it has been two weeks since you received the one required dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
- Visitors will be asked to remain on their loved one's unit and not walk about the facility.
- Compassionate care visits may occur as per DPH guidance.

We look forward to welcoming you back to our center and we encourage you to get the COVID-19 vaccine as soon as you are eligible to receive it.
